Please note that the application is to be filled by only one educator from the staff of the school but it is highly recommended that the teachers together with SLT discuss it beforehand.

The webinar will be held online, therefore teachers will be able to follow the session from the comfort of their own homes. Educators may use a computer, laptop or tablet to connect to the meeting, which will be held on the eTwinning platform. Participation is strictly by registration and interested educators are kindly asked to send an email to the eTwinning National Support Service on etwinning@ilearn.edu.mt and request to join the meeting by not later than Tuesday 14th January 2020. The eTwinning National Support Service will then contact all the teachers interested and send them a participation link.
